

What is Diphtheria, Tetanus & Polio?

- Diphtheria, Tetanus, Polio- 3 in 1:
- Diphtheria-A bacterial infection which can cause breathing problems and damage to the heart and nervous system.
- Tetanus- Bacteria found in the soil.
 Enters the body via a wound- painful disease affecting the nervous system causing muscle spasms, breathing problems and can kill.
- Polio- A virus that attacks the nervous system and can cause permanent paralysis of muscles.





What is Meningitis ACWY?

- Meningococcal ACWY- 4 most common strains affecting young people.
- Meningococcal disease can cause Meningitis (swelling of the lining around the brain) and Septicemia (Blood poisoning).
- Can result in life changing disabilities, hearing loss, brain damage, amputation of limbs and at worst, death.

Meningococcal meningitis can kill in a matter of hours.

MENINGOCOCCAL BACTERIA CAN CAUSE SEPSIS OR MENINGITIS. BOTH ARE DEADLY.






What is Measles, Mumps & Rubella?

- (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- Measles- Cold like symptoms, rasheasily spread. Can cause pneumonia, meningitis, blindness and seizures.
- Mumps-Causes pain & swelling in ovaries & testes and is linked to infertility in Males. Encephalitis (rare complication)
- Rubella (German Measles)- spotty rash. Rare illness but can have serious implications for pregnant women as it can affect the unborn baby; eg miscarriage, hearing loss, blindness heart defects.

How will I have the vaccination?

- DTP-5th and final dose completing the course
 - MEN ACWY
- MMR only required if outstanding
- immunisations Offered to all year 9 student's
 - Catch-up offered if missed
 - Vaccines given in deltoid muscle/s
 - Short sleeved shirt
- Immunisation session held in school





Will I experience any side effects?

- It is possible to experience mild side effects after any vaccine such as:
- Headache
- Fever
- Sore arm
- Tiredness
- Nausea/upset stomach
- Any side effects are usually short lasting and can be managed with paracetamol or Ibuprofen if required.
